



DID YOU KNOW?

That Wisconsin's first air-cooled industrial engine, a single-cylinder model, was built in 1931. Forty years later the product line comprised 22 basic models of one, two and four cylinder engines ranging from 4.6 HP to 65.9HP. Before 1931, only liquid cooled engines were offered by Wisconsin Motor.

The five millionth Wisconsin engine was delivered by August, 1971, sixty-two years after the company was founded and only 18 years after the first two million engines were built.
